Event Date & Location: November 14-15, 2025 at Florida SouthWestern State College, 8099 College Parkway, Ft Myers FL 33919, on the Lee Campus, Hendry Hall (Bldg K).

Event Schedule: BSides SWFL will offer engaging talks and workshops, interactive villages, and opportunities to connect. The pre-conference workshops are scheduled for Friday. A call for proposals is currently open, with details being made available when registration opens.

The conference is scheduled for Saturday, with registration starting at 8:00am, followed by the opening ceremony and keynote speaker at 9:00am. The day will end with a closing ceremony and keynote speaker at 4:00pm. The conference day will offer:

- Speaking Tracks that cover a broad spectrum of information security disciplines and topics, offering attendees insights into the latest trends, research, and best practices across the cybersecurity landscape.
- Capture the Flag (CTF) competition hosted by SimSpace. Seasoned or new participants will have the opportunity to test their skills in real-world cybersecurity challenges, solve puzzles, and compete against peers.
- Interactive Villages to foster a collaborative, informal learning environment where attendees can gain practical skills, network with experts, and explore niche interests beyond the main conference talks. (They're often some of the most popular and memorable parts of a security conference.)
